## **WHAT IT IS**

The Society for California Archaeology executive board has implemented an annual virtual presentation series in recognition of California Archaeology Month. The Board is offering a student-grant of \$2500. Students will be asked to host, via Zoom, an hour long live virtual presentation on their current thesis or doctoral research, taking place in late October.

## **HOW IT WORKS**

The event will consist of a twenty-minute presentation followed by a roundtable discussion between the student and a three-person panel of their choosing. The panel should be made up of established professional archaeologists relevant to their research. To apply for the grant, students need to submit a brief recorded video that outlines their proposal and a statement on how the grant would support their research. Additionally, the student must submit a written list of four professional archaeologists who are familiar with the subject matter and would be good potential discussion panelists, with explanation of their relevant credentials (need not be thesis/dissertation committee members).
